HEALTH CARE AND SANITATION- THE WAY FORWARD	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The church, government and communities need to improve health care, sanitation and hygiene by sending trained people in rural areas, towns and villages to teach the people how to live healthy by providing guidance on hygiene. Washing hands, cleaning their community, footwear, boiling water for drinking if there is no pumped water, building latrines, washing food before eating to name a few 2. The church, government and communities need to train people about health care delivery, sanitation, and hygiene especially in rural areas, towns and villages 3. The church, government and communities need to have proper planning, allocation and management of funds to implement its health care, sanitation and hygiene programs 4. The church, government and community need to repair existing medical facilities and construct new ones to carry on a good health care system

HEALTH CARE AND SANITATION- THE WAY FORWARD (cont.)	5. The church, government and community need to educate the citizens on the dangers and consequences of drug abuse and by training people how to handle drugs properly. Discourage importation of harmful drug production by educating the consumer on the dangers of these drugs to their health

	7. The church, government and community need to create awareness and education programs on diseases throughout the nation, communities, families and individuals. Education will help to reduce the spreading of these diseases.
